The college aligns with the evaluation reforms established by Gondwana University, as outlined below:

- 1. The examination cell ensures the fairness of the evaluation process.
- 2. Maintenance of internal examination records is a responsibility of the college's Examination Cell.
- 3. Students are actively encouraged to dedicate themselves to their studies and are motivated for improved performance in upcoming examinations.
- 4. The college strictly adheres to the University's guidelines for conducting internal assessments.
- 5. Faculty members assign homework to students as part of their academic responsibilities.
- 6. Organizing study tours and visits to research centers is a regular practice.
- 7. Internal assessment is mandatory at the college level.
- 8. B.A. I, II, III students undergo theory-type examinations.
- 9. Providing photocopies of answer books for students to review their results is a standard practice.
- 10. Environmental Science B.A. II-year students are required to complete a project.
- 11. Semester VI students must undertake a compulsory project on Research Methodology.
